## DEFINITIONS AND METHODOLOGY

Measure	Persistence rate
<b>Purpose</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Describes the educational pathways of Maritime university students at a broad level.</li> <li>• Measures whether a student re-enrolls at a Maritime university.</li> <li>• Assists in the understanding of student pathways, including movements between institutions.</li> </ul>
<b>Definitions</b>	<p><b>Persistence at the university of first entry</b> Percent of the cohort that re-enrolls at the university of first entry in subsequent years, regardless of registration status or field of study.</p> <p><b>Persistence at the system-level</b> Percent of the cohort that enrolls at any Maritime university in subsequent years, regardless of registration status or field of study.</p> <p><b>Notes:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Persistence is measured in the fall term.</li> <li>• The student may be enrolled full- or part-time, or on a co-op work term, and/or may have changed programs.</li> <li>• Students who ‘stop out’ (i.e., leave their studies for a year or more but return) are counted when they re-enrol.</li> </ul>

<b>Purpose</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Describes the educational pathways of Maritime university students at a broad level.</li> <li>• Measures the degree completion rate of first-time full-time students at the Maritime university system level</li> </ul>
<b>Definitions</b>	<p><b>Graduation rate at the university of first entry</b> The percent of the cohort that completed an undergraduate degree at the same institution within x years of first enrolling.</p> <p><b>Graduation rate at the system-level</b> The percent of the cohort that completed an undergraduate degree at any Maritime institution within x years of first enrolling.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> The measures are cumulative.</p>

<p>The definition of cohort approximates the population which enters university directly from high school:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New student at a Maritime university in the fall term</li> <li>• Aged 19 or less on December 31st in the cohort year</li> <li>• Enrolled full-time in a program leading to a bachelor’s degree. Full-time is defined as enrolment in at least 60% of a full course load:  <math display="block">\text{Number of credits to be considered FT} = (\text{Total \# program credits} / \# \text{ of semesters}) \times 0.6</math> </li> </ul> <p><b>Note:</b> Students can be part of more than one cohort if they meet the definition at another university in subsequent years. i.e. new at an institution in the fall term, aged 19 years or less.</p>	

## Discipline Cluster

The Discipline Clusters are based on the Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) 2016 Primary Groupings as defined by Statistics Canada: <http://www23.statcan.gc.ca/imdb/p3VD.pl?Function=getVD&TVD=394056>

The following CIP primary groupings have been combined for analysis:

- 'Humanities' and 'Social and behavioural sciences and law' and 'Visual and performing arts, and communication technologies' and 'Other' are combined into '**Humanities, arts and social sciences**'.
- 'Agriculture, natural resources and conservation', 'Physical and life sciences and technologies' and 'Mathematics, computer and information sciences' primary groupings into '**Sciences and mathematics**'.
- 'Education', 'Architecture, engineering, and related technologies' and 'Health and related fields' are combined into '**Applied and professional programs**'.

## MPHEC's Longitudinal PSIS data file

The measures in this report were created using the MPHEC's Longitudinal Postsecondary Student Information System (PSIS) data file.

This file includes:

- 153,934 individual first entry, bachelor students.
- 16 cohorts (fall 2001 to fall 2016); over 8,800 students per cohort.
- At least 6 years of data for the fall 2001 to fall 2011 cohorts.
- Longitudinal information at the system-level across institutions for each student including the first program and the program completed.
- Demographic information including gender, age, and student origin.
