Doctor of Counselling and Psychotherapy	New	The Yorkville University Doctor of Counselling and Psychotherapy is a practice-oriented doctoral-level program rooted in the “scholar-practitioner” model of professional education. The program emphasizes competencies for advanced counselling and psychotherapy practice. Students complete course work focused on an area of specialization within either mental health counselling and psychotherapy or couples and family therapy. Students are required to earn 60 credits during 10 terms, culminating in the capstone project, which includes three components: (s) Publishable and Critical Literature Review (PCLR); (b) Appropriate Research Question, and (c) Appropriate Methodology. The DCP program facilitates advanced training in counselling and psychotherapy and career advancement while preparing the highly competent counsellor and psychotherapist to contribute community service. To be considered for admission, applicants must (a) possess a master’s degree in counselling or a related discipline, (b) be qualified to or already have registration or certification as a counsellor or psychotherapist, and (c) be currently employed (full-time or part-time) in counselling practice or have access to individual clients as a volunteer. Both degree options would require 9ch in compulsory courses and a 3ch elective, plus either a 12ch thesis or an additional 3ch compulsory course, 3ch elective, and a 6ch capstone project completed over 3-4 terms.
