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### **MPHEC Graduate Survey Program**

The Commission is now in its 15<sup>th</sup> year of its graduate survey program. To ensure that the program continues to provide value and relevance for the region, and that it addresses information gaps that have emerged, it is reviewing its Graduate Survey program. As part of this review, it is considering an expansion of the scope of surveys conducted to include both graduates and students. Such an expansion would enrich, and provide a Maritime context for, the measures being developed using Maritime PSIS (Postsecondary Student Information System) data, for example, further characterizing who persists and why, who leaves and why. It would provide continuity between the student experience and graduate outcomes. A well-designed survey program would enrich our knowledge of student pathways and the factors affecting outcomes.
